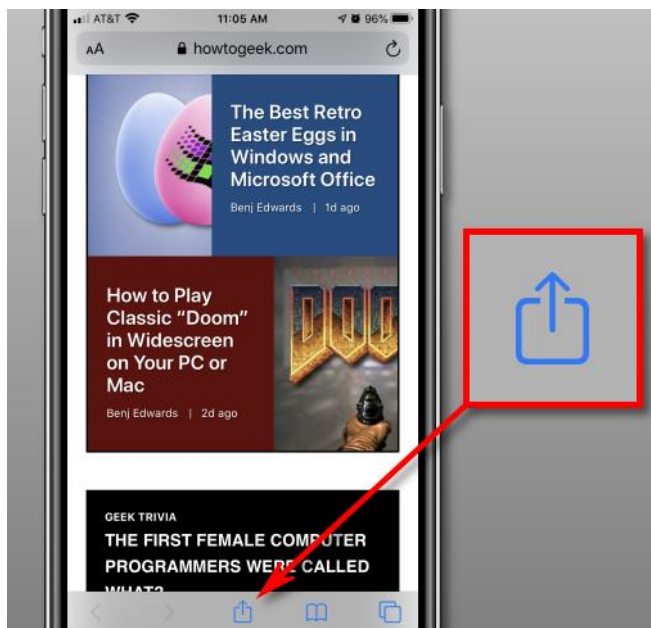


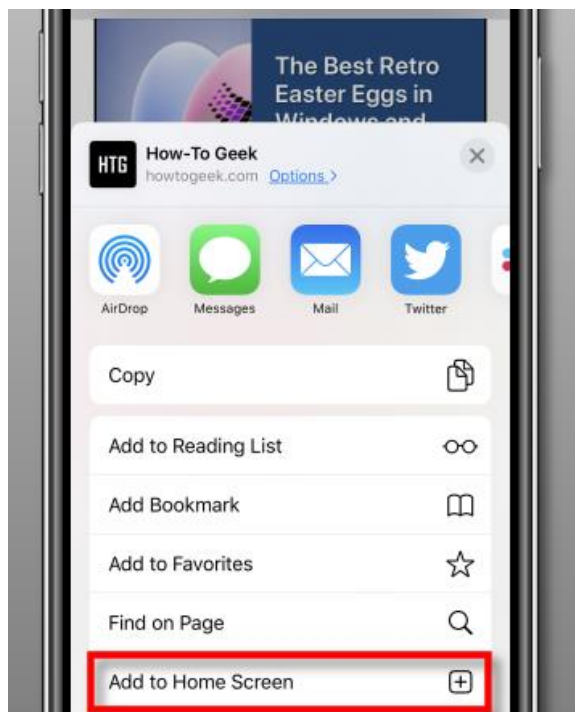
Add a Website to Your iPhone Home Screen

First, open Safari and navigate to the website you would like to put on your iPhone's Home screen. (CHSU self-screen site can be found [here](#).) Once there, make sure you can see the navigation toolbar by tapping once near the bottom of the screen, which will make it appear.

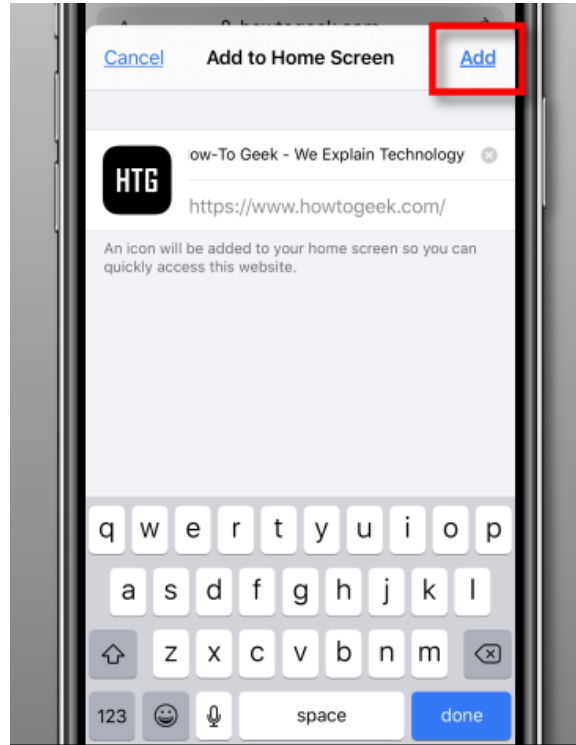
On the navigation toolbar at the bottom of the screen, tap the Share icon (the rectangle with an upward arrow).



A Share menu will appear at the bottom of the screen. Use your finger to pull it up and swipe through the list. Tap "Add to Home Screen."



A menu titled “Add to Home Screen” will appear. Use this menu to name your new Home screen web icon or keep the default name that appears. Once you are done, tap “Add” in the top-right corner of the box.



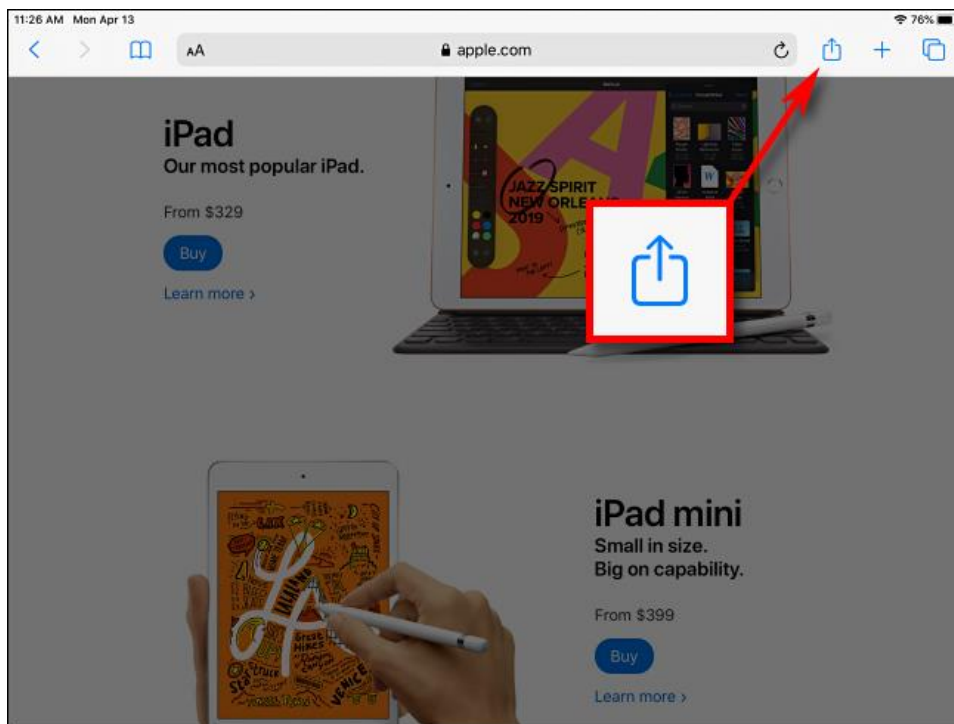
The icon for the website will appear on your Home screen. Any time you would like to use it, just tap on the shortcut as if it were a regular app. Safari will automatically open and load the website.



Add a Website to Your iPad Home Screen

On your iPad, open Safari and navigate to the website you would like to put on your Home screen. (CHSU self-screen site can be found [here](#).) Once there, make sure you can see the navigation toolbar by tapping once near the top of the screen, which will make it appear.

On the navigation toolbar at the top of the screen, locate the Share icon (the rectangle with an upward arrow). Tap on it.



A Share menu will appear on the right side of the screen. Tap “Add to Home Screen.” Follow the same instructions as above.

More About the Web Shortcut Icon

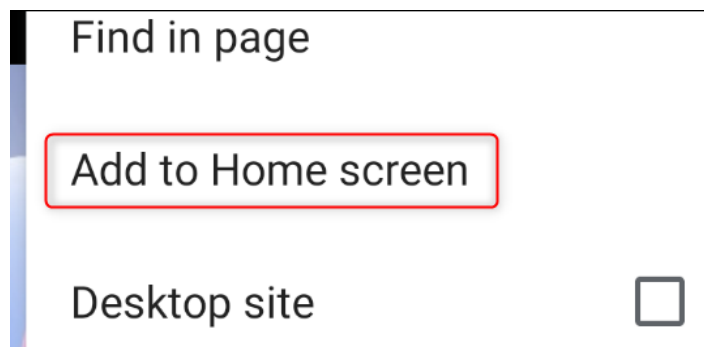
The website icon we created with Safari looks and behaves like a regular app icon on the iPhone’s or iPad’s Home screen. You can [rearrange it](#) along with other apps, add it to a folder, or even drag it to the Dock.

Add a Website to Your Android (or other non-Apple device) Home Screen

Open the Chrome app on your handset and navigate to the website that you want to make into a Home Screen shortcut. Once the website loads, open Chrome's Settings menu by tapping the three vertical dots found in the top-right corner.



Next, select the "Add to Home Screen" option.



A new screen that will allow you to place the icon automatically or choose where to place it. On this "Add to Home Screen" screen, you will see a preview of the shortcut's icon. Tap the "Add Automatically" button to place the new icon on your Android device's Home Screen wherever space is available.

If you want to place the icon somewhere different on your Home Screen, touch and hold the icon, and drag it to your desired location.
