California Health Sciences University was founded in 2012 and is the first university of its kind in the Central Valley. CHSU offers a local option for health care professionals seeking doctoral and continuing education programs to help remedy the shortage of health care services offered in the Valley.

- Completed English 1A
- Earned a minimum GPA of 3.0 in all prerequisite coursework completed at the time of signing
