- Student must be in good academic standing and not on academic probation.
- Independent Study Elective Course can be taken as a stand-alone or longitudinal/concurrent simultaneously with other OMS-IV course and must be completed in the same academic semester.
- 1 (one) credit unit is assigned for each 15.0 clock hours completed.
- Grading is Pass/Non-Pass. Upon completion of course, the course director will submit the final grade to the Registrar's Office.
