

**Job Title:****Librarian, Research and Instruction, University****Job Description:**

The Research and Instruction Librarian is responsible for providing library services in support of research productivity, teaching, and learning. Reporting to the Director Health Sciences Library, this faculty position participates in the formal educational efforts of the library, including the development of instructional materials, research guides, web tutorials, videos, and other support services. The incumbent provides consultations and instruction in bibliographic research methods, evidence-based medicine, research data management, scholarly communication, and systematic reviews. This position markets and promotes the resources and services of the library and cultivates and sustains collaborative relationships with students, residents, faculty, preceptors, and staff in support of campus research, teaching, and learning. The Research and Instruction Librarian also serves as librarian liaison for our CHSU medical and health sciences programs.

- Provides information, reference, and consultation on research tools, using and retrieving the literature, and effectively managing citations with bibliographic management software.
- Develops, maintains, and promotes program and research guides.
- Provides expert literature search services supporting education, research & scholarly activities, systematic reviews, and research data management.
- Participates on committees in support of research, teaching, and clinical care.

**Instruction:**

- Designs and delivers courses, seminars, tutorials, and webinars supporting evidence-based practice, information literacy, and research development across the university, using course management systems, screen casting, and web conferencing.
- Provides instruction on effective searching of biomedical databases, critical appraisal of search results, and point-of-care resources.
- Serves as a liaison to CHSU programs and participates in collection development activities.

**Marketing and Outreach**

- Creates announcements, brochures, displays, exhibits, and signage, both independently and in collaboration with the CHSU Marketing Department.
- Contributes to the development and maintenance of the library's website.
- Creates surveys and reports assessing the library's resources and services.

- Master's degree from an ALA-accredited library and information sciences program.
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills.

- Experience in the design and delivery of user-centered information literacy and evidence-based medicine instruction for adult learners within a healthcare environment.
- Experience in the development of instructional materials, program and research guides, videos, and web tutorials.
- Skill in designing and delivering team-based learning or other active learning instructional sessions.
