The Department of Clinical Sciences seeks an energetic, team-oriented, highly collaborative individual to join as a faculty and patient care simulations coordinator committed to student success.

Preference will be given to those with academic, didactic and laboratory teaching experience. Candidates with backgrounds in other community or clinical pharmacy practice areas also are encouraged to apply. We are considering applicants at the assistant or associate professor level.

Job Description:

The faculty and simulation coordinator will be responsible for developing and coordinating Patient Care Laboratories, preparing, and maintaining laboratory materials and technologies related to simulation learning at the COP, CHSU. The Simulation Coordinator also provides academic instruction to pharmacy students that is appropriate to one's field of expertise, as assigned by the Department Chair. Additional responsibilities include participation as an active member of assigned college or university committees, scholarship and research, and service as a faculty advisor to students.

The essential functions (i.e., the fundamental job duties of the position) are as follows:

1. **Simulations:** Prepare and maintain patient care laboratory materials and technologies related to simulation learning and support the development of faculty teaching courses utilizing all levels of clinical simulation.
2. **Didactic Teaching:** Contribute to the didactic teaching load of the Department, including development or maintenance of course materials. The amount of teaching will be assigned annually by the Department Chair with consideration given to the faculty member's clinical duties.
3. **Service:** Active service on committees of the College or University, and service as faculty student advisor, as assigned.
4. **Scholarship:** Scholarly contributions to the discipline and profession. Scholarship goals determined in consultation with Department Chair considering clinical and didactic teaching load. Actively participate in events and activities of the College and University.
