The *Fresno County Economic Development Corporation* is a private non-profit organization established to market Fresno County as the premier location for business prosperity. We strive to not only facilitate site selection for new businesses within Fresno County, but we also assist in the retention and expansion of local businesses. Having a qualified workforce and high quality of life are major components in our efforts to attract new business to Fresno County. The opening of a new medical school would contribute to that, as well as benefit our citizens and community.
